Position - Sports Show Radio Presenter (Volunteer)

Job Purpose

We are seeking a number of talented people with a passion for the people and places of South Durham to present a range of sports programmes.

Activities

Reporting to the Programme Director(s), and working with other volunteers you will:

1. Be the on-air talent hosting / co-hosting one of our sports radio programmes (2 - 6pm every Saturday + other opportunities to coincide with local sporting events and activities)
2. Have a background / qualification / an interest in sport and or journalism, with a passion for sharing that with people in South Durham in an interesting and informative way
3. Be aware of and work within the terms of the station's music licences, our station Style & Presentation Guide and meeting the requirements of Ofcom's Broadcasting Code
4. Have well developed IT skills, preferably with previous experience of working in a broadcasting environment

Volunteer Commitment

Our best estimate is that this role will require an average of 2-10 hours per week of volunteer time.

The times would depend upon our programme schedule and your availability, with some degree of flexibility.

There are occasions where you will be expected to work alone.
